



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
type 1: basic growbed setup





type 1: variations





benifits:

- very simple setup
- when digging in the fishtank, growbeds can be positioned low

<u>disadvantages:</u>

- fluctuating water levels in fish tank
- pump pums dirty water


remarks:


- with cold water fish, it is advised to place the fish tank in the ground (not isolated) and to work in open air
- with warm water fish, it is recomended to work in a isolated room or greenhouse



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type 2: fish tank above grow bed





benifits:

- water level in fish tank remains stable
- well suited when tanks cannot be placed in the ground.
- when digging in the sump tank, growbeds can be positioned low

<u>disadvantages:</u>

- when sump cannot be in the ground, grow beds positioned higher.
- sump tank needed

remarks:

- Tube outlet of the fish tank can also be drilled through the side. it is recommended to place an internal pipe to suck bottom water.
- Make sure the drain level (which determins the tanks water level) is below the tanks edge: the water level will rise above drain level to build up pressure.
- with cold water fish, it is advised to place the fish tank in a cool place.
- with warm water fish, it is recomended to work in a isolated room or greenhouse
